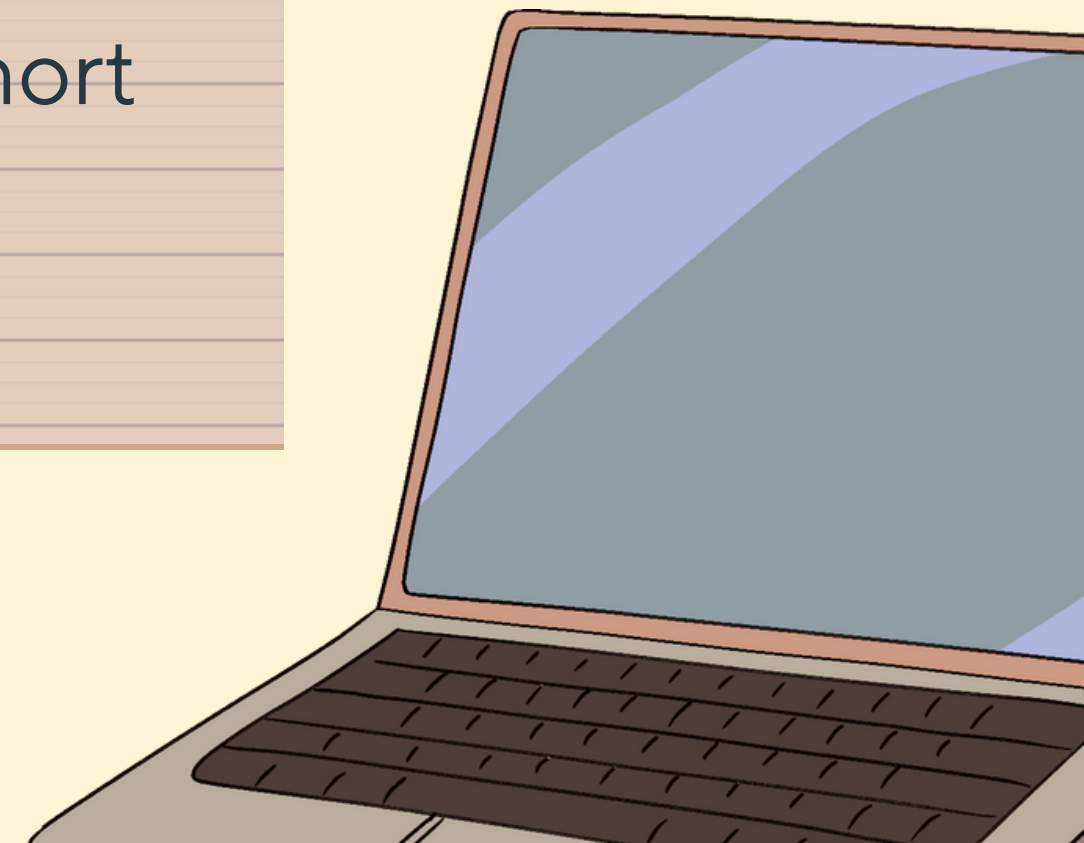
Jack London

- Profound



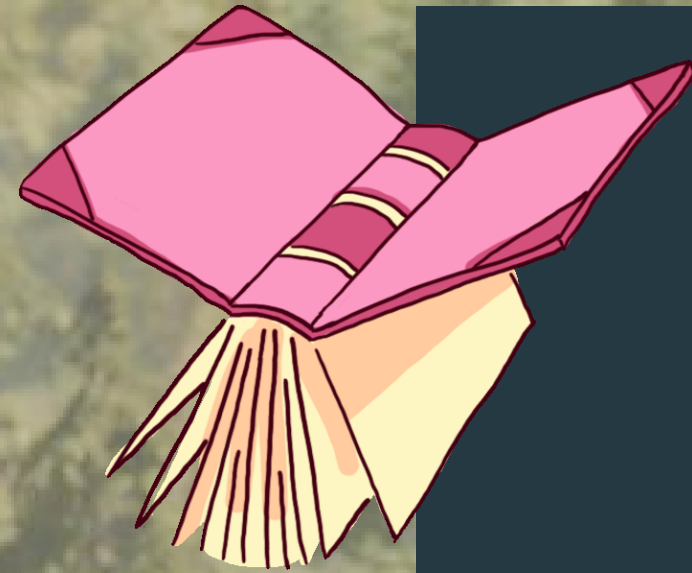
WEAKNESSES
